ABOUT THE NURSING PROGRAM

As a nursing major at George Fox, you will prepare yourself for a rewarding career in a field that combines medical expertise and compassion. Graduates of our nursing program go on to work in clinics, hospitals, research facilities, doctors' offices and other health care positions throughout the country. Our nursing graduates are also equipped to pursue graduate education and fulfill the need for nurses in advanced practice, higher education and management.

The program has been granted full accreditation from the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) and the Oregon State Board of Nursing. Upon completion of the nursing program, you will be eligible to take the NCLEX-RN state-licensing exam. Our graduates are overwhelmingly successful on this exam. In 2011, 100 percent (31 of 31) of our nursing graduates who took the exam passed. What further distinguishes our program is the fact we offer a Christian college environment that encourages not only academic – but spiritual – growth.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission to George Fox University:

1. Transfer students interested in applying to George Fox University should submit an undergraduate application for admission. Applications may be found at apply.georgefox.edu, or request an application by calling 800-765-4369 x2240.
2. Regular decision dates for submitting a completed application
 - a. Fall Semester – May 11, 2015, Applications completed after this date will be considered only as space is available
3. Transfer students need a college Grade Point Average (GPA) of a 2.8 or higher to be regularly admitted. All Transfer/2nd degree students have until June 25, 2015 to submit official transcripts. All other parts of the application process is due May 11, 2015.
4. George Fox only accepts the Associated of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree (AAOT), the Washington Transfer Associates of Arts (WTAA), or any associates from California in which the student meet the IGETC requirements as meeting general education, excluding Bible/Religion requirements and any specific general education courses required by the major.

Please note that fulfillment of pre-requisite requirements does not guarantee fulfillment of general education requirements.

Admission to the Nursing Program:

Students must first apply and be admitted to George Fox University before they can apply and be admitted to the nursing program. **It is suggested applications for undergraduate admissions are completed by March 1, 2015.**

DEADLINE: Completed applications plus all required documentation due at the Department of Nursing **by May 11, 2015.**

- All students must submit an application into the nursing major.
- Admission into the nursing major is very competitive.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 is REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION of an application; this includes all transfer courses. **NOTE:** This minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 **is not** considered when applications are evaluated and reviewed for an admission decision. A second GPA, using first-year required prerequisite courses, will be calculated to assist in determining, in part, one's qualifications for admission into the major. (See GPA prerequisite requirements)
- It is strongly recommended that all science prerequisite course work be completed within the last five years.

In order for admission into the nursing major, the following criteria MUST be met and included with the application:

- HESI Admission Assessment Exam (A2)
- Two Essays
- Two Recommendation and Appraisal Forms
