## 2013-2014 Alumni Association Student Scholarship

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The George Fox University Alumni Association board of directors is responsible for awarding an annual three-year scholarship. As long as the scholarship recipient meets the requirements each year, there will be no re-application process necessary. Granting of this scholarship follows the regular application and award practices of Student Financial Services. Members of the Alumni Association Board of Directors will screen all applications, choose a select few to interview and make the granting decision.

### AMOUNT

A three-year award of \$2500 per year, totaling \$7500.

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Student must be anticipating to graduate in Spring 2016. Scholarship will begin Fall 2013 and last three years.
- Alumni Association Scholarship applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 through fall 2012.

### CRITERIA

- Alumni Association scholarships are not need-based.
- Legacy students (children/grandchildren of alumni) will be acknowledged but this is not a requirement.

### DEADLINES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

*Application deadline is **Monday, February 11, 2013, 5 p.m.** Applications must be received in the Office of Alumni & Parent Relations (Pennington House, Box #6049) by 5 p.m. that day.*

The Alumni Association Board of Directors will screen all applications, choose a select few to interview and make the granting decision.

### SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- Serve as a student representative on the Alumni Board of Directors and attend quarterly meetings.
- Attend and represent students at University Advancement events each year.
- Assist with select Bruin Heritage and Alumni & Parent Relations events each year.
- Lead the Senior Giving Challenge and help with any other giving initiatives for your class.
