RESPONSIBILITIES:

Schedule and conduct practice sessions, hire and supervise assistant coaches, recruit student athletes, budget management, and some fund raising. Attend clinics and seminars for professional growth. Schedule travel arrangements for team. Maintain NCAA conference and GFU guidelines. Teach Health and Human Performance courses.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

Bachelor’s degree required, Masters preferred. Successful coaching and recruiting experience required, preferably at the collegiate level. Extensive knowledge of Lacrosse required, including strong familiarity with NCAA Division III guidelines. Mentoring the overall development of the student athlete is an integral part of the GFU coaching culture and an expectation of this position. Good interpersonal and communication skills. Evangelical Christian commitment and lifestyle consistent with the university’s mission as described on our website is also required. Candidates should also value a climate that reflects the diversity of God’s kingdom, one that engages and connects culturally. Female candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.
