

Dear President Baker:

Pursuant to the recently passed House Bill 2117, the Office of Degree Authorization is required to issue a separate license to grant degrees to each school that meets the requirements for exemption from ongoing evaluation by our office by virtue of meeting the conditions for this exemption as set forth in statute ORS 348.597 (2) (d), which states that regulation does not extend to a school, or separately accredited campus of a school, if the school:

- A. Is a nonprofit school that is exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code;
- B. Conferred degrees in this state under the same control for at least five consecutive years; and
- C. Is accredited by a regional accrediting association or its national successor;

As an independent college in Oregon that has met the conditions stated here above, we are issuing the enclosed license to your school to fulfill our obligation under law to provide a separate license to grant degrees in the state of Oregon. This license shall remain in effect as long as your school continues to meet the conditions listed above.
