Group Project - A Strategic Planning Project in the capstone course, MGOL 450, Strategic Management. The assessment asks students to complete a strategic planning document for proposal to high-level managers in an organization. They are encouraged to integrate learning from the entire cohort program and specific learning from the Strategic Management course. The project will be evaluated by a rubric designed for this project. (Active)

Target: 90% of students will receive 85% or greater on this project.
