



2010-2011 Regent Law World Changer Scholarship

AFFIRMATION OF CHRISTIAN MISSION AND SCHOLARSHIP PURPOSE

The mission of Regent University is “Christian Leadership to Change the World”. Therefore, Regent University School of Law has established the World Changer Scholarship (WCS) for qualified applicants who are called to the high responsibility of Christian lawyering and have demonstrated spiritual maturity, exceptional character, integrity and academic excellence.

THE WCS CRITERIA

Only students who are admitted to Regent Law and have submitted all required documentation will be considered for the scholarship (see checklist below). All materials submitted for admission including the personal statement, resume and faculty recommendations, will also be considered during the scholarship decision.

The 2010-2011 WCS is based on the following LSAT/UGPA criteria; however, final award decisions are subject to the discretion of the law school:

- 161+ LSAT & 3.2 UGPA = \$24,000 to full-tuition scholarship
- 158–160 LSAT & 3.2 UGPA = \$16,000 to \$24,000 Scholarship
- 155–157 LSAT & 3.2 UGPA = \$8,000 to \$16,000 scholarship
- 152–154 LSAT & 3.2 UGPA = up to a \$8,000 scholarship

THE WCS CHECKLIST

- ☑ Submit a Regent University School of Law Application for Admission, available online at www.regent.edu/lawapplication.
- ☑ Submit a Regent University School of Law Financial Aid Application online at www.regent.edu/lawfinances. Enter via the application’s “Comments” box:
 - “WCS” and name of undergraduate institution
 - Name and title of the person who will provide the WCS letter of recommendation
- ☑ Provide a letter of recommendation from a faculty member, Pre-Law Advisor, Career Services Officer or Academic Dean from the applicant’s undergraduate institution. This letter is in addition to the letters of recommendation required for admission, and may be received via mail or e-mail to the addresses below.

THE WCS TERMS

Award levels for this scholarship significantly exceed those generally awarded for individuals in similar score ranges; therefore, recipients typically are not awarded supplementary law school scholarships or grants. The Regent Law Navigators scholarship renews annually at the previous amount provided the student maintains a spring cumulative grade point average of 3.0. All scholarships and grants are subject to the School of Law Financial Aid Policies & Procedures.
