

## **2008 CAC "New In Two" Opportunity**

Between April 10 and April 25 you will have the unique opportunity to trade your two year old CAC issued laptop in for the 2008-2009 CAC model year laptop.

### **Why Offer This Opportunity?**

In I.T. we have been listening to your requests and one of the most requested items is the ability to upgrade to a newer model CAC laptop. Because George Fox University has decided to go all Apple with the CAC program this coming year, you have a wonderful opportunity to upgrade your current two year old laptop for a brand new laptop at a great low cost!

### **How Does It Work?**

You will bring your two year old CAC issued laptop to the Service Desk and a value will be assigned to it by a full-time Service Desk employee. The value is based on information from Apple regarding resale value for a particular computer as well as some cost recovery calculations determined by the I.T. department. This value will be credited to you if you choose to trade in your old computer and purchase a new Apple CAC laptop.

### **When Will This Program Start?**

Requests to take part in this program will be taken at the I.T. Service Desk beginning March 17, 2008. Computer valuation and new computer distribution is scheduled to begin as close to April 1 as possible.

### **How Do I Pay?**

The Service Desk full-time technician who estimated the value of your computer will give you a document that states the value for this program's purpose and the balance you will owe to purchase the new Apple laptop. You will take that document to Student Financial Services and pay for your new upgraded CAC computer at Student Financial Services. You will receive a receipt for your purchase. You will bring the receipt back to the I.T. Service Desk and you will receive your new computer.
