



FoxTALE Quiz Retakes

Issue

How do I allow a participant (student) to retake a quiz?

Solution

You'll need to delete that participant's first attempt within the quiz's grading area. This will reset the participant's account and allow another attempt to be made in the quiz.

The path to delete a quiz attempt is:

1. Select the Quiz.
2. Select the hyperlink that shows how many participants/attempts have been made:

1 Participants have made 1 attempts

This produces a roster of all participants who have made attempts.

3. Select the check box for each participant that you want to 'reset'.
4. Select the **Delete** option in the dropdown menu:

Select all / Deselect all

This removes the participants selected (in step 3) and all of their submissions from the quiz.

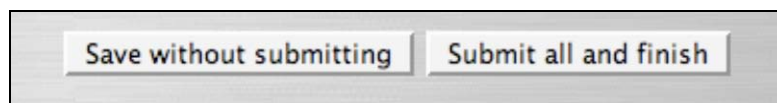
Please Note: The participant will be starting the quiz from the beginning. All data from the participant's previous attempt will be deleted.



Tip

Participants may experience technical problems while taking a quiz. It is a good practice to save answers periodically while working through the quiz. This allows the participant to re-enter the quiz and complete it, even if the quiz is set for **one attempt only**.

The participant can save responses while working through a quiz by selecting **Save without submitting**. This will store responses in the database without 'closing' the quiz for the participant:



Selecting the **Submit all and finish** button submits the participant's responses and closes the quiz.
