GEORGE FOX ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT

A minimum of 62 transferable semester hours from accredited colleges or universities.

LANE COMM. COURSES WHICH MEET REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of 93 transferable quarter hours. **Most** LANE COMM. courses with letter prefix and numbered 100-299 are acceptable with the following exceptions: Technical courses and those with numbers less than 100 will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis. A maximum of 18 quarter hours of practicum or Cooperative Work Experience will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

NOTE: You may choose to complete the Oregon Transfer Degree in lieu of George Fox University's general education requirements which are listed below.

1. A minimum of 62 transferable semester hours (93 quarter hours). Lane courses must be numbered 100 to 299.
2. A grade of “C” or above in all courses presented for transfer. George Fox University does not accept for transfer any course work with a grade below “C”.
3. A minimum of 5 years of qualifying work experience.
4. Resume.
5. Two letters of recommendation from persons qualified to assess academic or professional competency.
6. A writing sample, to be assessed by the George Fox University faculty, that demonstrates competency needed for success in the program.
7. Completed application and \$40 nonrefundable application fee.

A maximum of up to 30 semester hours may be granted for credit for prior learning through the development of an experiential learning portfolio. Students with more than 62 transferable semester credits will require less portfolio credit.

** Management and Organizational Leadership Curriculum or Management of Human Resources Curriculum:

Students complete a 15-month, 34-semester-hour “senior year” MOL or MHR curriculum.

Management and Business Information Systems Curriculum:

Students complete a 17-month “senior year” MBIS (36 semester hours) and SBS (37 semester hours) curriculum.
