Mentor Responsibilities

An P2P Mentor is a returning George Fox student (Ss) who had demonstrated leadership qualities that enable their peers to seek them for advise, friendship, and support. Mentors will be participating in team-building, leadership training and camp-style fun. This time is planned with structured and unstructured activities to help incoming students transition into life at George Fox University. A P2P Mentor will have a small group of students and help them *affirm identify, build community, and cultivate leadership*.

Mentors requirements:

- Diversity sensitivity of underrepresented Ss in ethnicity, socio-economic status, ability, first-generation, third culture kid (TCK), and Christian background/denomination
- Provide peer advising within individual limits in areas of: personal, spiritual, financial, social, academics, or other interests not listed
- Familiarity with services offered around campus, especially leadership opportunities in MSP, Associated Student Community (ASC), Spiritual Life (SpiL)
- Willingness to be trained and supervised by the Director of MSP and MSP Assistant(s)
- Assist in promoting good morale and constructive attitudes within the team
- Initiates contact with new students through inclusion, conversation, respect
- Supports or does not openly disagree with university regulations
- Communicates and models behavior and policy expectations of George Fox
- Helps set-up/clean-up of activities and meals
- A minimum GPA of 2.5
- Does not have other obligations that will interfere with pre-orientation (ie: Fall sports, RA, peer advisor.) Must commit to **Sat, Aug 18 – Sat, Aug 25, 2012**, this time is set aside for training, pre-orientation retreat and helping with orientation.
