



DAY USE GUIDELINES

Tilikum is open for individual use on a limited basis, provided usage does not interfere with scheduled guest groups.

- Availability is when staff are present, and won't interfere with campers or retreat center guests
- Guests may only visit Tilikum with prior approval, so call the office in advance to schedule your visit
 - If no one is available when you call, then there is NOT approval for the visit
- Available activities include hiking, picnicking, and fishing
- Swimming and Boating are NOT permitted (per Oregon State Law for camps, lifeguards must be on duty for these activities)
- Guests must register in the camp office upon arrival and check out prior to departure. A GFU photo ID is required from all GFU staff & students
- Pets, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or possession of any weapons are strictly prohibited while on Tilikum property
- Tilikum reserves the right to ask any individual to leave its premises if necessary

FISHING POLICY

Fishing is a special privilege that is extended only to guests at Tilikum with prior permission.

- We encourage catch and release – if you want to keep your fish, we do have a catch limit: 3 fish per day (please release bass larger than 12")
- Boats are NOT available for fishing (must fish from docks or shore)
- Please do not clean fish on Tilikum property.
- Donations for restocking are encouraged
- A license is not required at Tilikum
- Part of the privilege of fishing at Tilikum includes periodic solicitation of donations to help improve the fishing program at Tilikum
