## Director

**Bryan Boyd** is a theatre artist and a professor at George Fox University, where he directs the University Players and runs the design and technical theatre program. He has toured nationwide with the one-man play *Damien*, designed scenery and lighting for professional theatres in Portland and Seattle, and been named a Celebrated Teaching Artist by the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts. A convinced Quaker, Bryan appreciates the exploration of corporate discernment as a model for collaboration in theatre. In the summers, Bryan runs the Theatre Design Institute, a series of graduate courses for high school theatre teachers.
