

Scholarship Awards: Criteria and Application Process

Department of Professional Studies (DPS) George Fox University 2018 - 2019

The faculty and staff of the Department of Professional Studies (DPS) serve as the Scholarship Award Committee for the DPS endowed scholarship funds. It is the intention of this Committee to award a scholarship each fall and each spring semester to deserving applicants who are selected solely by this Committee. Both scholarships will be in the amount of \$450. The following guidelines apply to applicants:

- ❖ Applicants must be taking degree completion cohort courses at the time of application.
- ❖ Applicants must be current in all required coursework (i.e., no “incomplete” grades pending).
- ❖ Applicants must demonstrate passion for academics, community service, and leadership.
- ❖ Applicants must complete the online FAFSA and have it sent to George Fox University (school code 003194) to demonstrate a financial need. If you have already submitted a FAFSA for the 2018-2019 school year, you do not need to submit it again.
- ❖ Applicants must submit their professional resume.
- ❖ Applicants must include a letter of recommendation from a professional reference.
- ❖ Applicants must use MyGFU to download and print an unofficial copy of their transcript. This transcript must be attached to the formal application.
- ❖ Applicants must submit a 1- to 2-page summary of their professional goals, specifying how their major will help to meet those goals.
- ❖ Preference is given to students who are not currently receiving other scholarships, grants, or waivers (e.g., Veteran Administration benefits, Foundation grants, etc.).

Applications will be reviewed by DPS faculty using the following criteria:

a. Scholarship based on GPA (1 to 10 points)

- 3.000 – 3.250 2 points
- 3.251 – 3.500 4 points
- 3.501 – 3.750 6 points
- 3.751 – 4.000 8 points

Plus 1 point for 6 semester hours or more of LACC/GE or elective courses graded and earned at GFU.

Plus 1 point for 12 semester hours or more of LACC/GE or elective courses graded and earned at GFU.

b. Professional Goals Summary (1 to 10 points)

- clear summary of career aspirations
- connection of DPS major to professional goals
- specific language/examples
- professional ambition/focus

c. Professional Resume (1 to 10 points)

- related experience
- clear presentation
- professional achievement
- leadership/service activities

d. Professional Reference (1 to 10 points)

- student's personal qualities/challenges
- student's potential in chosen profession
- student's commitment to completing degree
- general observations/comments

e. Financial Need (1 to 10 points)

- Plus 10 points for a demonstrated financial need
- Minus 4 points if receiving other scholarships
- Minus 3 points if receiving grants

(Total: 50 points possible)
