

Transfer Guide for: Clark College
George Fox University Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education – Adult Degree Completion Program

Note: Clark College is on a quarter system, while George Fox is on a semester system. **Any credit taken at Clark will be worth 2/3 credit at George Fox.** Remember to take this into consideration when figuring out how many credits will transfer from Clark.

Transfer Overview: A maximum of **135 quarter** or **90 semester** hours will be accepted from community colleges.

- Only coursework with a grade of “C-” or better will be accepted.
- Courses must be 100-level or higher
- One quarter credit = 2/3 semester credit

Completion of an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree (AAOT) or comparable degree (DTA in Washington) will result in a block transfer to George Fox, meaning all general education courses will be considered complete.
