

Transfer Guide for: Linn-Benton Community College
George Fox University Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education – Adult Degree Completion Program

Note: Linn-Benton Community College is on a quarter system, while George Fox is on a semester system. **Any credit taken at LBCC will be worth 2/3 credit at George Fox.** Remember to take this into consideration when figuring out how many credits will transfer from LBCC.

Transfer Overview: A maximum of **135 quarter** or **90 semester** hours will be accepted from community colleges.

- a. Only coursework with a grade of “C-” or better will be accepted.
- b. Courses must be 100-level or higher
- c. One quarter credit = 2/3 semester credit
