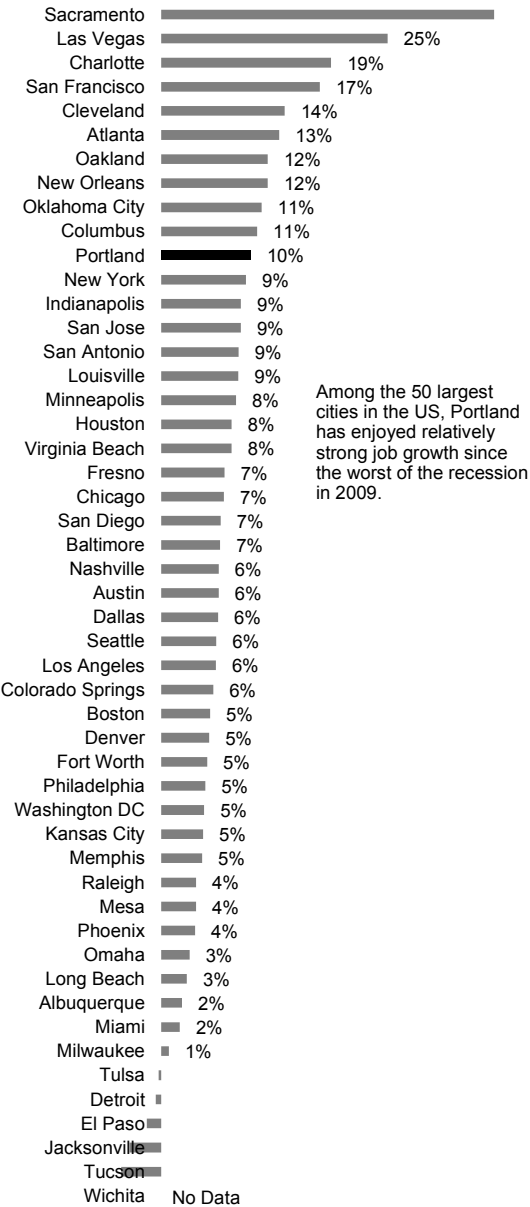


**Job Growth by City**

**Job Growth by City**

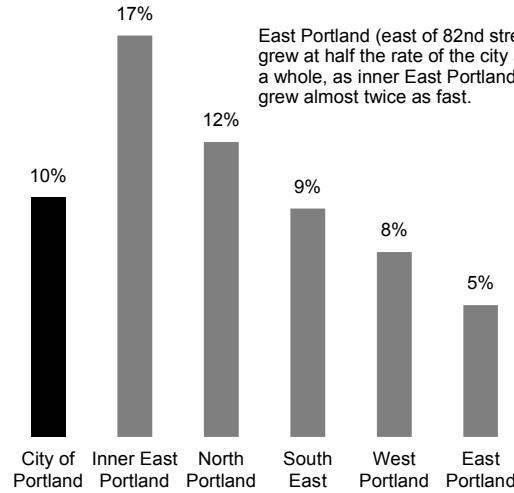
Portland Area Cities : 2009 to 2013

2009 to 2013

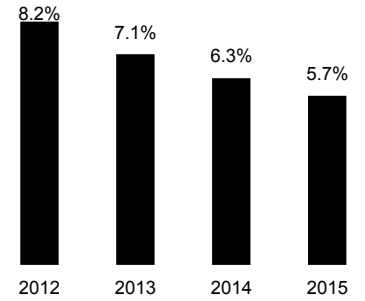


East Portland (east of 82nd street) grew at half the rate of the city as a whole, as inner East Portland grew almost twice as fast.

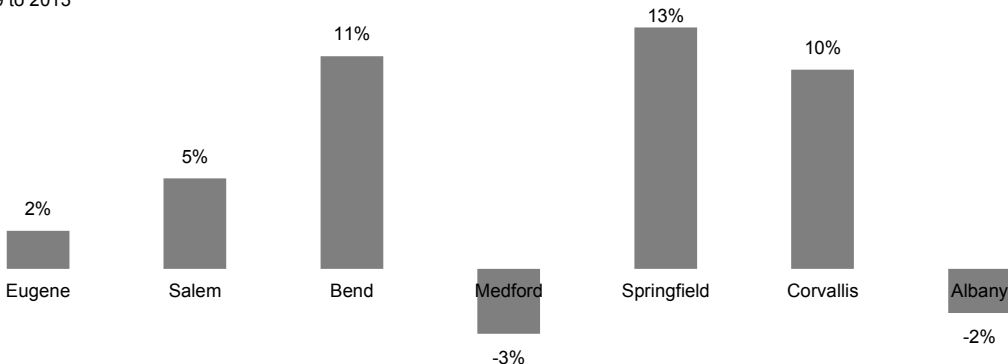
