



## Rose Descriptions

The following rose descriptions are from *Modern Roses XI: The World Book Encyclopedia of Roses*, ISBN 0121550532, © 2000 Harcourt Brace/ Academic Press. The numbered entries correspond with the Virginia Millage Memorial Rose Garden brochure listed varieties, and are arranged in the following order: variety, class, year introduced, parentage, flower, fragrance, growth habit, awards, American Rose Society (ARS) color class. When™ follows the variety it indicates the rose was currently patented at time of planting.
