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ABOUT THE NURSING PROGRAM

As a nursing major at George Fox, you will prepare yourself for a rewarding career in a field that combines nursing expertise and compassion. Graduates of our nursing program go on to work in clinics, hospitals, research facilities, doctors' offices and other health care positions throughout the country. Our nursing graduates are also equipped to pursue graduate education and fulfill the need for nurses in advanced practice, higher education and management.

The baccalaureate degree program in nursing at George Fox University is accredited by the Commission of Collegiate Nursing Education (www.ccneaccreditation.org). George Fox School of Nursing is also approved by the Oregon State Board of Nursing (OSBN). What further distinguishes our program is the fact we offer a Christian college environment that encourages not only academic – but spiritual – growth.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission to George Fox University:

1. Transfer students interested in applying to George Fox University should submit an undergraduate application for admission. Applications may be found at apply.georgefox.edu.
2. Decision dates for submitting a completed application
 - a. Early Action – November 1. Regular Decision – January 15. Applications completed after this date will be considered only as space is available.
3. Transfer students need a college Grade Point Average (GPA) of a 2.6 or higher to be regularly admitted.
4. George Fox only accepts the Associated of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree (AAOT), the Washington Transfer Associates of Arts (WTAA), or any associates from California in which the student meet the IGETC requirements as meeting general education, except for a few courses that are tied specifically to our institutional mission. *Please note that fulfillment of pre-requisite requirements does not guarantee fulfillment of general education requirements.*

Admission to the Nursing Program:

Students must first apply and be admitted to George Fox University before they can apply and be admitted to the nursing program.

DEADLINE: The application deadline can be found on the school of nursing website nursing.georgefox.edu.

- All students must submit an application into the nursing major.
- Admission into the nursing major is very competitive.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.9 *in prerequisite courses only* is REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION of an application; this includes all transfer courses.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.9 *in prerequisite math and science only* is REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION of an application; this includes all transfer courses.
- It is strongly recommended that all science prerequisite course work be completed within the last five years.

In order for admission into the nursing major, the following criteria MUST be met and included with the application:

- HESI Admission Assessment Exam (A2)
- Two Recommendation and Appraisal Forms
- One Essay
- One page Resume
