### Footwear on the Field

For graduates' safety and the protection of the turf, high heels will not be allowed on the football field. Graduates should plan their attire accordingly, as the stadium surface is not safe for high, narrow heels. *Anyone wearing spike heels will be provided with alternate footwear for the ceremony.*

### Regalia

Students should wear their school issued regalia when participating in the commencement ceremony. This includes the cap, gown, cords, and stoles that are distributed by a department within the university. This does not include cords bought from or made by other distributors. It also does not include any additional outer garments worn on top of the school-issued regalia with exception of some ethnic items ([see policy](#)). Graduates may personalize their regalia by decorating the top of their cap as they wish.
