DESCRIPTION

This individual is responsible to the VP of Activities. The Blue Zone Director must plan, and promote Blue Zone events in collaboration with Athletics, Bruin Heritage and Student Athletic Advisory Committee (SAAC). These events include: Events in support of athletics, the Polar Bear Swim, The Blazers and Timbers game and any sporting events put on in the Foxhole. They must be responsible for recruiting a committee of students who are passionate about school pride. They will be responsible for 2 Coordinators to aid them in the planning of events.

QUALIFICATIONS

This individual must demonstrate strong leadership skills. They are expected to be able to set and accomplish goals, be creative, stay organized, and delegate responsibility. They need to be able to communicate effectively with their coordinators.

Applicants must be full-time students (minimum of 12 credit hours) in good standing with George Fox University for the duration of the time they hold their position. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required at the time of application and must be maintained for the duration of the position.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Meet with the Activities Committee weekly
- Meet with the VP of Activities individually bi-weekly
- Plan and execute Blue Zone events
- Hire and oversee two Blue Zone Coordinators
- Turn in report of each event, due the week following the event to the VP of Activities
- Turn in a year-end report to the VP of Activities
- Abide by all GFU community lifestyle standards as outlined in the Student Handbook
