SAFETY PRACTICES - HEAT & GAS FIREPLACES



Do NOT block or cover thermostats. A restricted thermostat may result in inaccurate room temperature readings.



Do NOT block or cover heat vents. Heat from a blocked heat vent could create a fire hazard.



Be aware of the location of your heat vents. Some vents are located on the floor. (Photo is of a floor vent.) Regardless of the location, heat vents should NOT be blocked.



The gas fireplaces across campus have timer switches located near the glass doors, so the glass doors do not open. For your safety, do not pry open fireplace glass doors.
