

Nursing Transfer Articulation Agreement
between
Corban University
and
George Fox University

This articulation is to establish the agreement between Corban University (CU) and George Fox University (GFU) for the following coursework included in an Associate of Science in Health Science (ASHS). Students who complete an ASHS at CU and meet the requirements listed below may transfer to GFU and apply to the School of Nursing. At least three and up to five spaces will be reserved for fall transfer admits from CU beginning fall of 2022. Ten spaces will be reserved for spring transfer admits beginning spring of 2023. Additional spaces may be available in spring. Completion of the articulated coursework at Corban will guarantee that students have covered all their nursing prerequisite and general education requirements towards the BSN.

Students pursuing acceptance into the Nursing Program at GFU, must complete all required transfer courses listed below as well as an ASHS from CU. Prior acceptance into the School of Nursing all applicants must apply for admission to GFU. This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and major specific courses for both CU and GFU and is subject to re-evaluation by both schools every three years for continuance.

Based upon space availability, students from Corban University will be eligible for priority transfer status when applying to GFU's Nursing Program if all the following requirements are met:

- Obtain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in all transfer courses listed in the articulation.
- Obtain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in science courses: SC214, SC214L, SC224, SC224L, SC234, SC234L, SC244, SC244L, SC304 and SC304L
- Students may only repeat one science course one time. In the case where a student has more than one repeat on any science course, only the grade from the first repeated course will be used. A "withdraw" from any science course will be counted as an attempt under this rule.
- A maximum of two repeated prerequisite courses is allowed (only one can be a science course)
- Completion of one essay
- One (1) page resume
- Demonstrate evidence of good citizenship and responsibility
- Final acceptance is contingent upon passing a background check and drug screen
- To be eligible for fall admit, all program required coursework must be completed by the end of the previous spring semester.
- To be eligible for spring admit, all program required coursework must be completed by the end of the previous summer semester.
- Additional general education coursework toward the ASHS must be completed prior to enrollment at GFU.
- Additional students may apply with the general transfer pool beyond the spaces reserved, but priority acceptance is not guaranteed.
