FAQ: Why do you need my Social Security Number?

We hope to never use your private information for collection purposes, but it may be necessary. Your SSN or ITIN is required for this purpose.

FAQ: What is the benefit to my student?

- Grants a Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) release for financially related information
- Required to apply for a monthly payment plan
