GENERAL INFORMATION

Please note that the University cannot guarantee specific spring housing assignments for students who participate in Off-Campus Studies programs during the FALL semester, but can guarantee a spot in campus housing.

If you are approved and participate in off-campus studies during the fall, here are tips for navigating the process of securing housing for spring semester:

1. Once you have been accepted (both by GFU and the off-campus studies program you are applying for), fill out the information on the front of this form and return it to the Student Life Office no later than May 1st. For consideration as part of housing selection this form must be submitted no later than March 17, 2017.
2. Listing potential roommates in different living areas will increase your chance of being placed with at least one of them.
3. If possible, arrange an “exchange” with another student who will be graduating in December or who will be participating in an Off-Campus Studies program in the spring. This exchange can be noted on the housing preference form.
4. If you are having a hard time arranging an exchange, you can place an ad in the “Wanted” folder on BruinBoards. The Registrar and Student Life Offices are unable to give out information about potential graduates or students participating in Off-Campus Studies programs due to educational privacy laws.
5. Ask questions—if you have any questions, please contact the Student Life Office. Always verify any housing information you hear with the Student Life Office.
6. If you are going to be a junior (62 cumulative credits or more) or 20 years old or older and wish to live off-campus, indicate “Off-Campus” as your preferred living area.
7. If we do not receive a form from you, that will be an indication that you will accept placement in any open location on campus.
