As our program is academically rigorous, academics accounts for half of the application matrix by scoring three of the following GPAs:

Credit Hour Math

One quarter credit hour = .67 semester credit hours

Applicants may fall within one full semester hour of the requirement*

*An exception is two five-quarter-credit-hour anatomy and physiology classes

Anatomy and Physiology: Eight semester hours

Qualifying coursework: Human-based only. Two anatomy/physiology classes OR one anatomy class with lab and one physiology class, lab not required. Advanced anatomy and physiology are accepted. Note: Anatomy and physiology courses that are a part of military training (with a pass grade) and as reflected on CCAF or JST transcripts are accepted (up to eight semester hours).

Qualifying coursework: Introductory to Psychiatry, General Psychology, Abnormal Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Psychology Throughout the Lifespan. AP credit or CLEP score will not meet this requirement.

Statistics: Three semester hours

Qualifying coursework: General Statistics, Behavioral Statistics, Biostatistics

Business Statistics will not be accepted. AP credit or CLEP score will not meet this requirement.
